Directions to Pasco Clubhouse

From I-82 (Hwy. 12), take the N. Oregon Ave. exit; going south until you come to a "T" in the road (E. Ainsworth). Turn right onto Ainsworth (but do **not** cross over the overpass). At this end of the overpass, turn immediately to the left onto 2nd St. and go to Washington St. Turn right on Washington to 3rd St. and turn right again. Go as far as you can on 3rd St., the clubhouse is on the right.

From the West on Highway 240, travel through Kennewick to Chemical Drive. Turn left over the Cable Bridge. At the end of the bridge, turn right onto W. Ainsworth going **over** the overpass. At the end of the overpass, turn immediately to the right onto 2nd St. and go to Washington St. Turn right on Washington to 3rd St. and turn right again. Go as far as you can on 3rd St., the clubhouse is on the right
